## Brambles retains #1 industry ranking in Dow Jones Sustainability Index

Supply chain group and operator of CHEP brand recognised as global industry leader

**Sydney, 11 December 2023:** Brambles today announced it had retained the leadership position in the Commercial Services & Supplies category in the 2023 Dow Jones Sustainability Index (DJSI). This is the second year Brambles achieved top ranking in its industry category and marks its 10th consecutive year as a DJSI World constituent.

The DJSI was the first global index to benchmark the sustainability performance of leading companies based on analysis of financially material Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) factors.

In the 2023 review, Brambles scored 71 from 100 against the category average of 23, with the assessment highlighting the company's broad strengths across all subsections.

Notably the scoring methodology and questionnaire for the 2023 Corporate Sustainability Assessment evolved to elicit a higher benchmark of performance from survey respondents and ultimately drive ESG progress.

Brambles' Chief Sustainability Officer, Juan Jose Freijo, said: "This DJSI rating confirms the breath and depth of our sustainability programme while also highlighting areas for improvement. Our regenerative vision and sustainability practices, shaped by the circular business model, are fundamental to the strategic aims of our organisation. We are proud of the role we play in making global supply chains more sustainable and honoured to be recognised in the DJSI rankings as a leader in our industry."
